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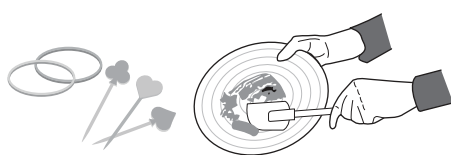

  - 不耐热（容易受热变形）的器具。
  - 耐热性低于 60 °C 的塑料器具等（含无耐热标识的器具）。
  - 容易生锈的器具如铁制的锅、菜刀等。
  - 开口较小、内部难以清洗的器具如瓶子、酒壶等。
  - 容易破损的器具，如已有裂痕、破损的器皿，裂纹釉餐具（有裂缝花纹的餐具），水晶玻璃、钢化雕花玻璃等。
  - 容易变色或涂层容易剥落的器具，如银制品、铝制品、铜制品、铁制品、涂漆餐具、贴金餐具、彩绘餐具等。

## 使用洗碗机前请先清理

### 烧焦烧糊

- 焗菜、蒸蛋后的器皿、烧焦的锅等的顽固污渍难以清洗，事先浸泡、清理。

### 食物残渣

- 可能导致再次附着：调料、香料、芝麻等细小残留物。
- 可能导致阀门故障：牙签、鱼骨、皮筋等。
- 可能导致产生异味：鱼皮等。事先清除食物残渣、异物。

### 油污严重

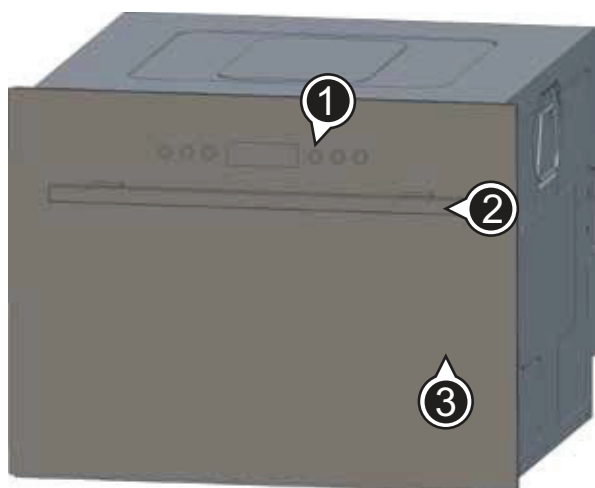
- 可能导致再次附着，事先手洗。

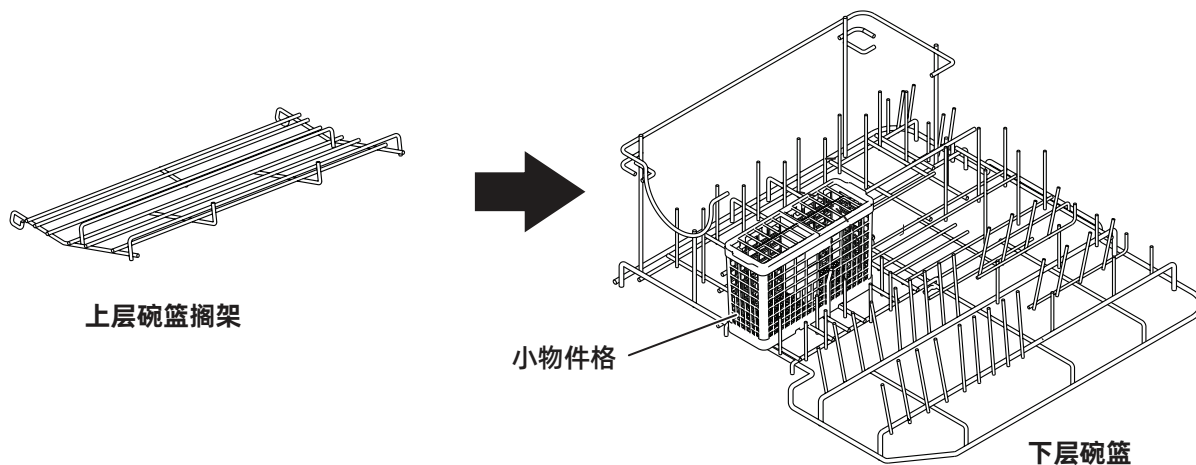

## 1. 准备

- 确认餐具都适合洗碗机清洗（第4~5页）
- 确认过滤网和喷嘴的安放状态

### 要求:

- 推拉机门请勿用力过猛过强。（否则容易因受到冲击导致机内餐具翻倒或破损）
- 关闭机门前请确认餐具等不要露出机外或碰到机体的边缘。

## 2. 放入餐具（第11页）

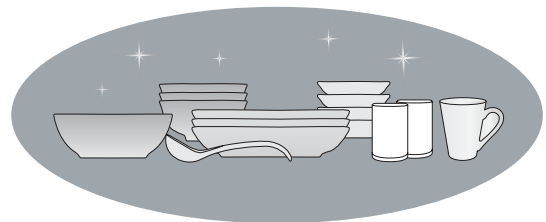
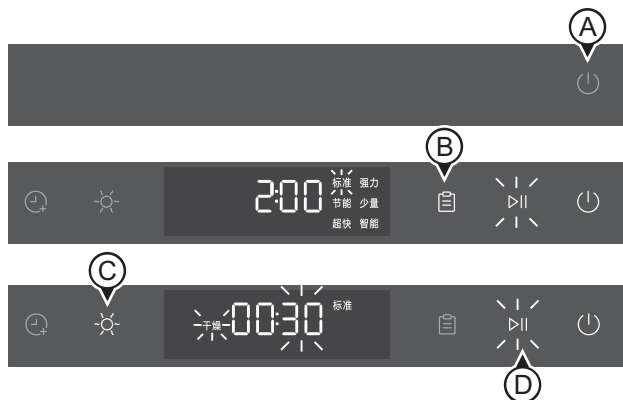

## 3. 放入洗涤剂（第17-18页）

- 只能使用洗碗机专用洗涤剂
- 请仔细阅读所购专用洗涤剂的注意事项，并遵照其说明使用

## 4. 洗涤~干燥（第19~21）

- 启动前，请务必关闭机门
- 以“标准洗”程序、干燥“30分”为例
  - A. 按下电源键，打开电源
  - B. 按下程序键，选择“标准”
  - C. 按下干燥键，选择30分
  - D. 按下开始/暂停键，启动

**要求:**

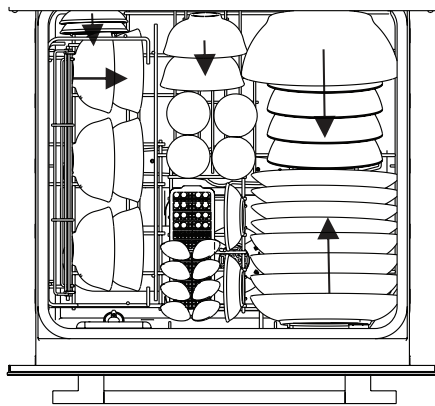
- 运转期间不得不打开机门时，请务必先按下开始/暂停键后慢慢打开，可能会溅出洗涤水。
- 运转期间，没有按下开始/暂停键就打开机门，则将停止运转。显示屏“门未关”闪烁，且有报警声提示。关好机门后可重新运转。

为防止机门开闭出现问题，发生蒸气泄漏、漏水，机体和餐具等的破损、变形，清洗不干净等现象，请遵守以下事项。

- 请勿叠放
- 碗盘等要朝内放置

- A. 请勿在上层碗篮和餐具上摆放砧板等
- B. 应向下放置

- E. 请勿叠放（会导致无法清洗）
- F. 筷子、锅的手柄等请勿露在碗篮底下（否则会阻挡喷嘴转动，从而无法清洗）

#### 提示：

下层碗篮可取出。按照以下步骤从洗碗机中取出下碗篮。

- 打开机门，首先将上层碗篮搁架按照示意翻转固定（图A）。
- 将碗篮左前部向上抬起（图B）。
- 再将碗篮右前部向上抬起，注意不要碰到机身内部的塑料螺母（图C）。
- 碗篮即可整体取出（图D）。

如果要将碗篮安装回洗碗机中，只需按照相反的步骤安装即可。

## 关于洗剂



### 添加洗剂的位置

添加专用洗涤剂、漂洗剂、专用盐时请务必加入正确位置，以免影响洗涤效果。

### 专用盐(软化水装置)

- 如果您所在地区的水硬度较高时，餐具、机内碗篮上等容易留下白色水垢。本产品可根据其水质硬度进行设置，加入专用盐后，自动将水硬度降低进行软化，从而达到更好的洗涤效果。
- 请咨询当地供水单位确认水质硬度，并进行以下设置，否则可能会多消耗专用盐、自来水或洗涤效果较差。

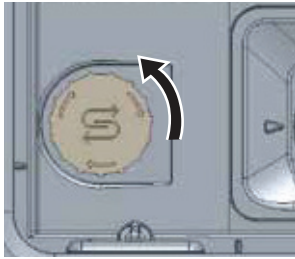
### 水质硬度设置

**提示：**确认关闭机门。

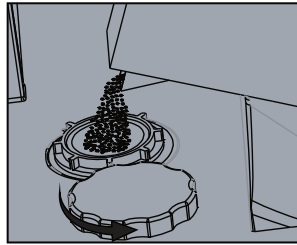
1. 在通电状态下，长按运行/暂停键，直到显示屏显示“H3”即进入设置状态。
2. 继续按开始/暂停键，会逐个依次显示：  
H4 ► H5 ► H6 ► H0 ► H1 ► H2 ► H3，  
(\* H3 为默认水硬度，代表约在200~300mg/L或ppm)。
3. 停留5s无其他操作，则自动确认所选档位。

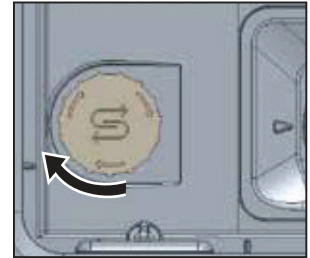

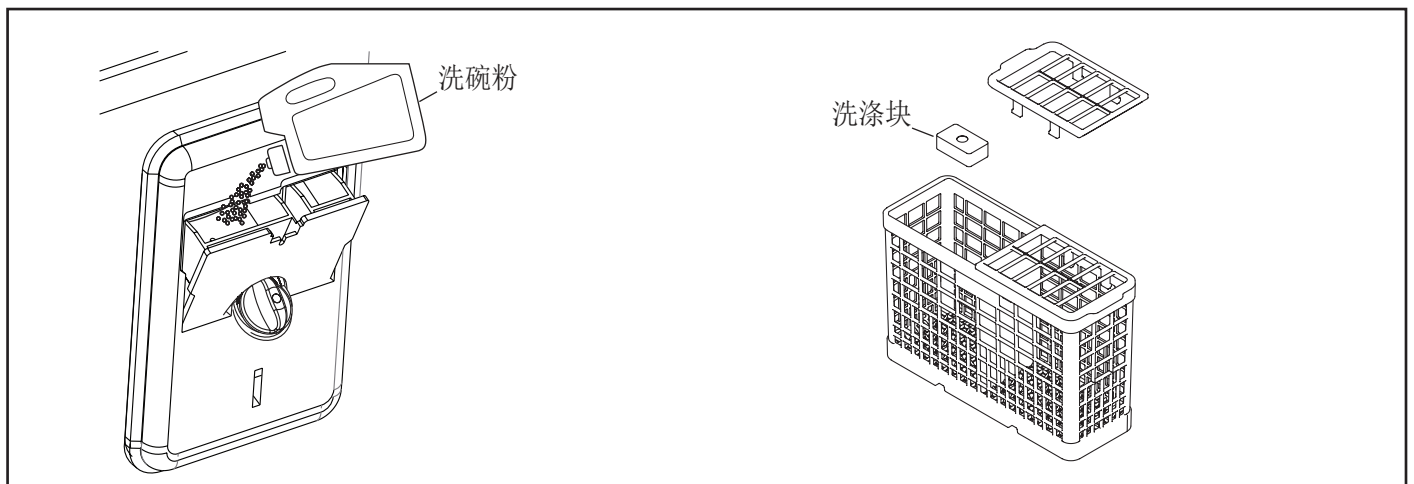
## 加盐方法

**提示：**确认关闭电源。

1. 掀起碗篮后，旋开盖子。
2. 直接倒入专用盐，单次大约添加500g左右。第一次使用时，还需注满水约250g，并充分搅拌溶解。
3. 完成后盖紧盖子。

### 提示：

- 请使用洗碗机专用盐（不可使用食用盐等），并仔细阅读所购买专用盐的注意事项，遵照其说明使用。
- 若使用含专用盐的多效合一洗碗机专用洗涤剂，水质硬度小于300mg/L时，可无需使用专用盐，大于300mg/L时，还需加入专用盐。

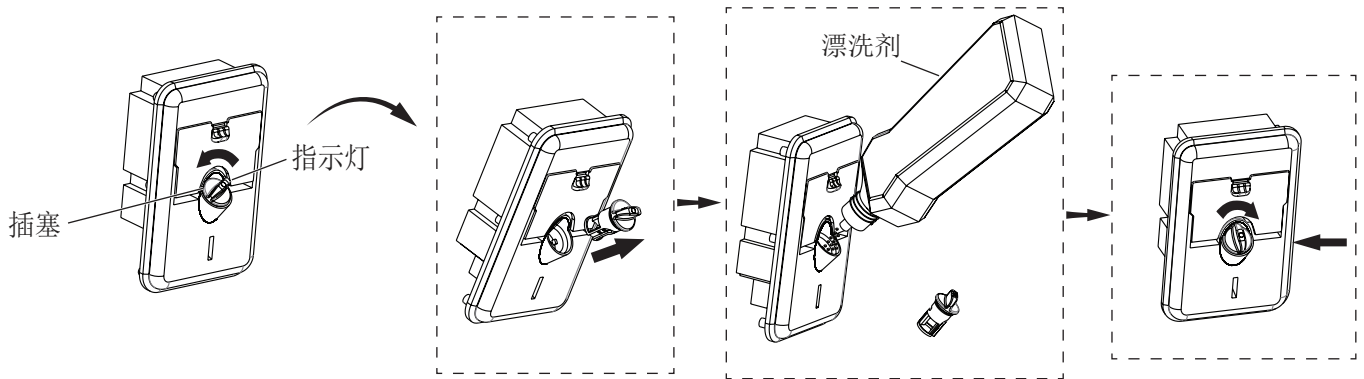


## 洗碗机专用洗涤剂

1. 将洗涤剂盒打开，检查添加器盒是否排空并干燥，导入洗碗粉。
2. 如果使用块状洗涤剂（洗涤块），请直接放入机内，可将小物格架盖子打开，将洗涤块放入架篮底部。

### 提示：

- 请仔细阅读所购洗碗机专用洗涤剂的注意事项，并遵照其说明使用。
- 使用洗碗机专用洗碗粉时，请先往机内放入少量洗碗粉（约4~5g，1小量勺用于预洗）再往洗涤剂盒内放入20g，（放入时请参照刻度线）。  
不要将洗涤块放入洗涤剂盒中，会影响洗涤效果。



### 添加漂洗剂

**⚠ 警告：产品存在受损风险。** 添加漂洗剂时请勿漏出，漏出时，请用干布擦拭干净，并选择“强力洗”程序洗涤。如果不擦拭干净，可能会造成泡沫过多，从而损坏洗碗机，导致保修失效。

**提示：** 请仔细阅读所购漂洗剂的注意事项，并遵照其说明使用。

- 洗碗机专用的漂洗剂（也有称为洗碗机专用“光亮剂”）可以清除玻璃杯、碗碟等上的水痕，使餐具光亮如新。
- 漂洗剂盒在抽屉的内部，在洗涤剂盒的下方。
- 使用漂洗剂时，使用量也可根据实际洗涤效果进行调整（第21页）。

按照以下步骤添加漂洗剂。

1. 逆时针旋转插塞并取下插塞。
2. 将漂洗剂加入圆孔中，注意不要溅到外面。
3. 将插塞重新插好，然后顺时针旋转到位。如确保插塞拧紧，保证插塞把手处于垂直方向。

漂洗剂什么时候添加，如果指示灯变红，表示需要添加漂洗剂，如果指示灯不亮或变暗，表示不需要添加，当前漂洗剂足够洗涤程序使用。

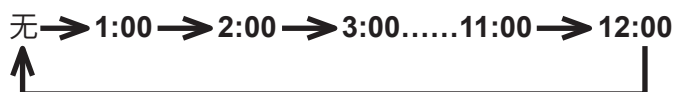

## 操作方法

**提示：**开始操作前,放入餐具（第11页）,放入专用洗涤剂（第17页）。

### 设置

1. 按电源键,打开电源。
2. 按程序键,选择洗涤程序,每按一次,可切换不同程序,直到切换到想使用的洗涤的模式/程序为止。

标准洗 → 强力洗 → 节能洗 → 少量洗 → 超快洗 → 智能洗 → 标准洗

3. 按干燥键,选择干燥模式,每按一次,可切换不同模式,直到切换到想使用的干燥模式为止,选择“智能洗”程序时除外。

干燥30分 → 干燥60分 → 加强干燥

4. 按开始/暂停键,开始运转。

### 取消 / 更改设置

一旦设置完成并开始运转后,若想取消/更改设置。

- 长按电源键2秒以上,关闭电源,即可取消设置。
- 若想更改设置,先按上述方法取消设置,再按照 **设置** 的方法,重新设置。

### 关于“保持干燥”

可保持机内干燥,防止餐具、机内结露,减少水滴残留,并吹散异味。

- 间歇性送风约24小时（部分型号为48小时）,因此会间歇性产生声音。
- 24小时（部分型号为48小时）后会停止该功能时。

### 在设置了“程序”、“干燥”程序后

- 按预约键,设置开始洗碗的时间,再按开始/暂停键,预约完成。
- 如果先选定预约功能,再选定洗涤程序,按开始/暂停键,预约是不生效的（显示屏不显示 **预约 保持**）。

- Take care of fixed rods at both side of Small object grid cell while removing from the lower bowl basket.
- When small object grid cells are dirty, soak them in water and rinse them.

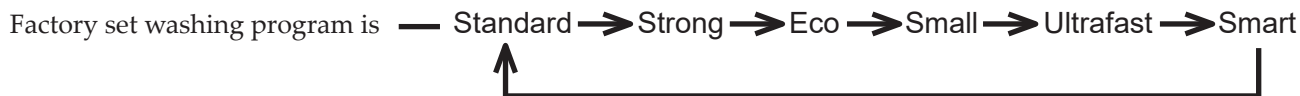


### 1. Power Button

- Once the Power is turned ON, press and hold the power button for about 2 seconds, the settings of the last operation are displayed by default.
- Press and hold the Power button to turn OFF the power.

### 2. Program Button

- Switch between washing modes every time when you press the Program button, and the display area will turn on the corresponding mode.



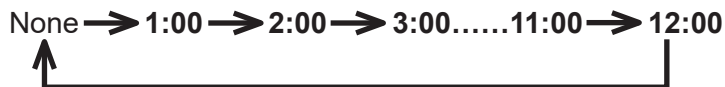
### 3. Dry Button

- Switch between drying durations every time when you press the Dry button, and the display area will display the corresponding drying mode and the duration.



### 4. Reserve Button

- The start time of reserve program is incremented by 1 hour for each press, up to 12 hours.



### 5. Start/Pause Button

- Press the Start/Pause button to start running. When running, press this button to pause and press again to continue

## 6. Display Area

### Displays the Time

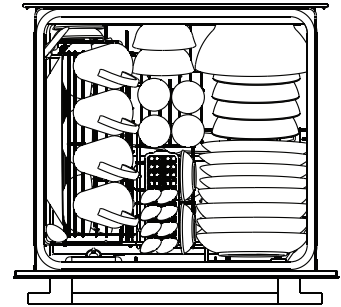
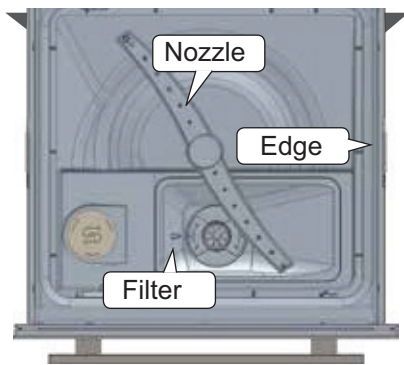

## Quick Start Guide



Put in the Tableware

### 1. Preparation

- Confirm that all tableware is suitable for dishwashing (Page 33-34).
- Verify the filter and nozzle's positioning status.

#### Requirements:

- Do not apply excessive force to push and pull the door. (Otherwise, it is easy to overturn or break the tableware in the machine due to impact)
- Before closing the door, Verify that the tableware is not exposed outside the machine or does not touch the edge of the body.

### 2. Put in the tableware (Page 40).

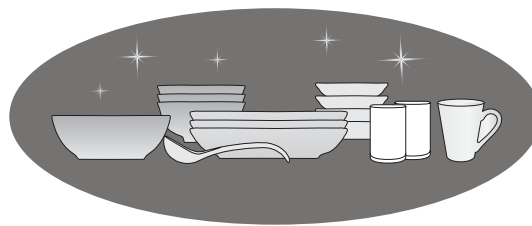
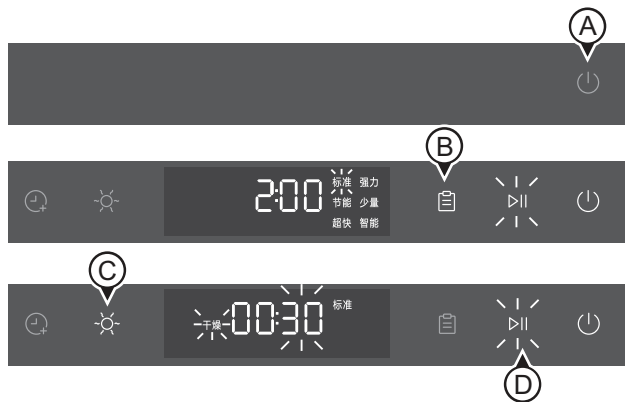
First classify the tableware and put that into the dishwasher according to the following points.

- First down and then up
- First small and then large
- First inside and then outside

**NOTE:** Please refer to Page 43 for the type and quantity of tableware that can be put in the machine.

### 3. Put in cleansers (Page 46-47).

- Only specific cleansers for dishwasher can be used.
- Read the precautions for purchasing special cleansers carefully and follow their instructions

#### 4. Wash-Dry(Page 48~50).

- Be sure to close the door before starting.
- Take the “standard wash” program and drying “30 minutes” as an example.
  - A. Press the Power button to turn on the power.
  - B. Press the Program button, select “Standard”.
  - C. Press the Dry button and select 30 minutes.
  - D. Press the Start/Pause button to start.

#### NOTE:

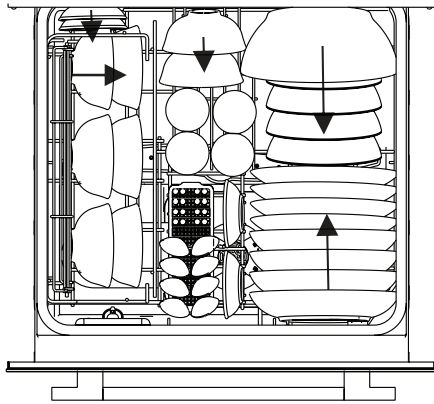
- When it is necessary to open the door during operation, be sure to press the start/pause button before slowly opening, washing water may spill out.
- During operation, if the door is opened without pressing the Start/Pause button, the operation will stop. The display flashes “Door Unclosed”, and there is an alarm prompt. Once the door is closed, the machine can be restarted.

#### 5. Complete

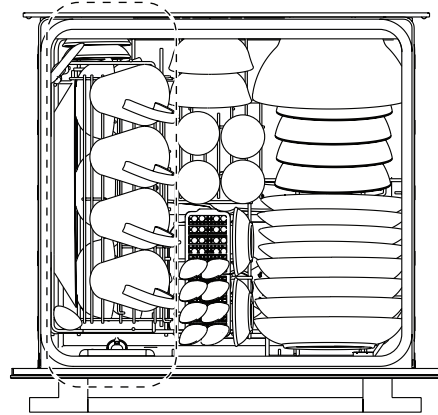
- You will hear “beep” for six times, after the operation is complete.
- Do not remove the tableware until 30 minutes after the operation is complete. Just after the operation cycle is complete, the machine’s interior temperature is still very high and can cause burn.
- Tablewares are clean and bright
- Clean the filter(Page 51).

**Suggestions:** It is recommended to remove tableware timely and remove food residues in the machine timely.(Otherwise it may cause mildew and odor.)

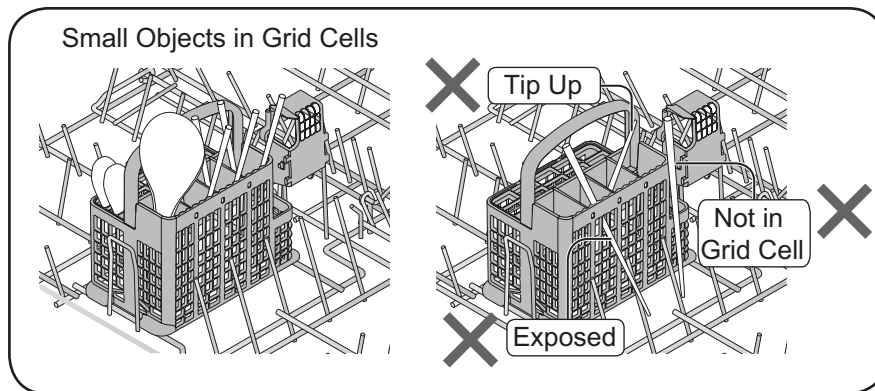

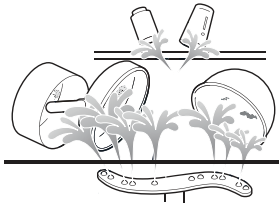

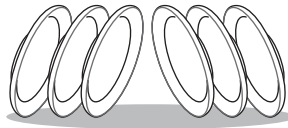
### NOTE:

- The tip of chopsticks, forks etc. should be placed downwards. The chopsticks can be placed along wavy lines on small object grid cells, and can be cross placed when there are many.
- When placing tableware with sharp corners and slender tableware, do not expose to the bottom of small object grid cells.
- The handles of spoons, soup spoons etc. are placed downwards.
- Be sure to place them in the small object grid cells. If any utensils drop from small object grid cells may block the nozzle from rotating.

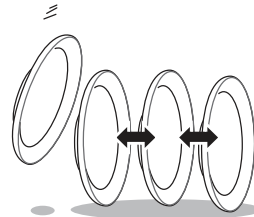












- A. Do not place the chopping board on upper bowl basket and tableware, etc.
- B. Place the tableware downward.
- C. The stained faces are placed inward.
- D. Do not place large pieces of tableware such as large pots below the upper bowl basket (otherwise it will block sprayed water and prevent cleaning of tableware on the upper bowl basket).
- E. Do not stack (which may cause failure to clean).
- F. Do not expose chopsticks, pot handles, etc. to the bottom of the bowl basket (otherwise it will prevent nozzles from rotating and thus cannot be cleaned). Be sure to put chopsticks and other small objects into a small object grid cell (otherwise they may drop out due to injection, resulting in faults, etc.).

**NOTE:**

- Tableware touching the resin part during placement or other improper placement may cause damage to the tableware, failure to open the door, or deformation of the body, leading to water leakage, steam scalding, etc.
- Do not force the door to open if it cannot be opened. Please contact Kohler Co.'s Customer Care Center.
- Stop using the dishwasher when it is deformed. Please cut off the power supply and contact Kohler Co.'s Customer Care Center.

**NOTE:** Requirements for the size of tableware that can be placed in this product are as follows:

- Deep plate, shallow plate, big soup bowl: < 230 mm in diameter.
- Seasonings plate: < 180 mm in diameter.
- Glass cup: < 150 mm height (\* 450 series glass cups can only be washed in the lower bowl basket)
- Tea cup: height < 90 mm.
- Big soup spoon: length < 250 mm.
- Rice bowl, noodles bowl: < 160 mm with upper bowl basket and < 300 mm without upper bowl basket.

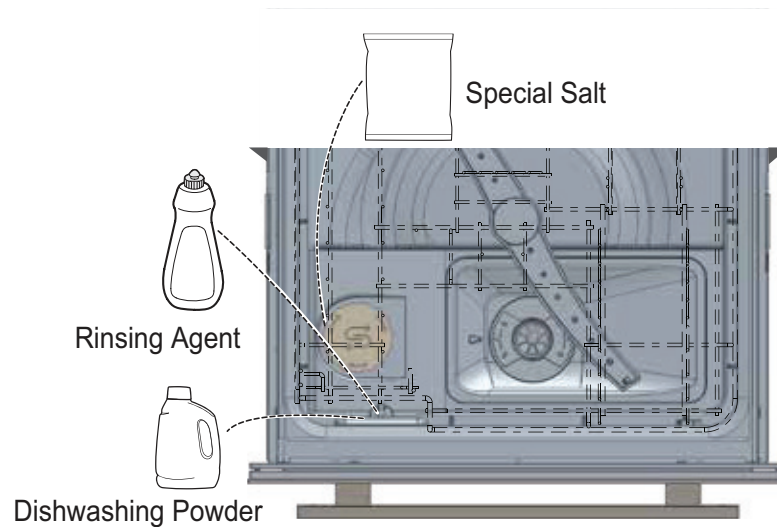
B. Lift the left front of the bowl basket up(see Fig.B).

## How to Add Cleaners



### Location Where Cleansers are Added

When adding special cleansers, rinsing agents, special salt, be sure to add them in the correct position to avoid the poor washing effect.

### Special Salt (Water Softening Agent)

- If your area has high water hardness, water will leave white scaling on tableware, internal bowl baskets, etc. This product can be set based on water hardness, which is used for washing. When special salt is added, the water hardness is automatically softened to achieve better washing effect.
- Consult your local water supply unit to confirm the water hardness and set the following settings, otherwise you may consume more specialized salt, tap water, or have poor washing results.

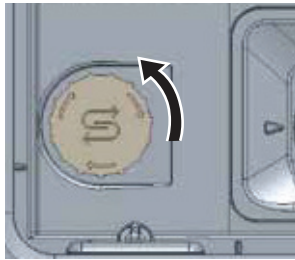

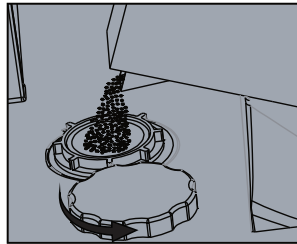
1. When powered on, press and hold the Start/Pause button until “H3” appears on the display to enter the setting state.
2. Keep pressing the Start/Pause button and display it one by one:

(\* H3 is the default water hardness, representing about 200 ~ 300 mg/L or ppm)

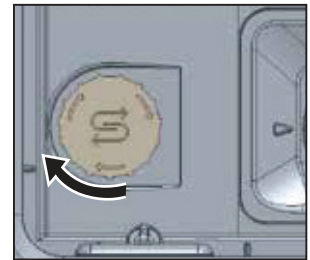

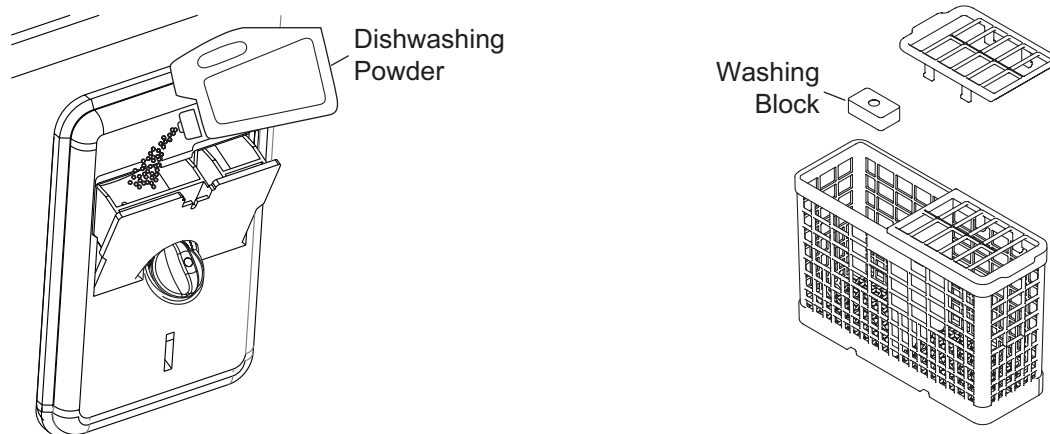
### Salting Method

**NOTE:** Confirm that the power is turned off.

1. After lifting the bowl basket, unscrew the lid.
2. Directly pour special salt into the compartment add about 500g per time. When used for the first time, fill the compartment with about 250g water and stir it fully to dissolve.
3. Close the lid after completion.

### NOTE:

- Use special salt for dishwashers (Do not use edible salt.) and read carefully precautions for purchased special salt and follow their instructions.
- No need to use Multi-effect special salt, if the water hardness is less than 300 mg/L or add special salt if water hardness is been greater than 300 mg/L.

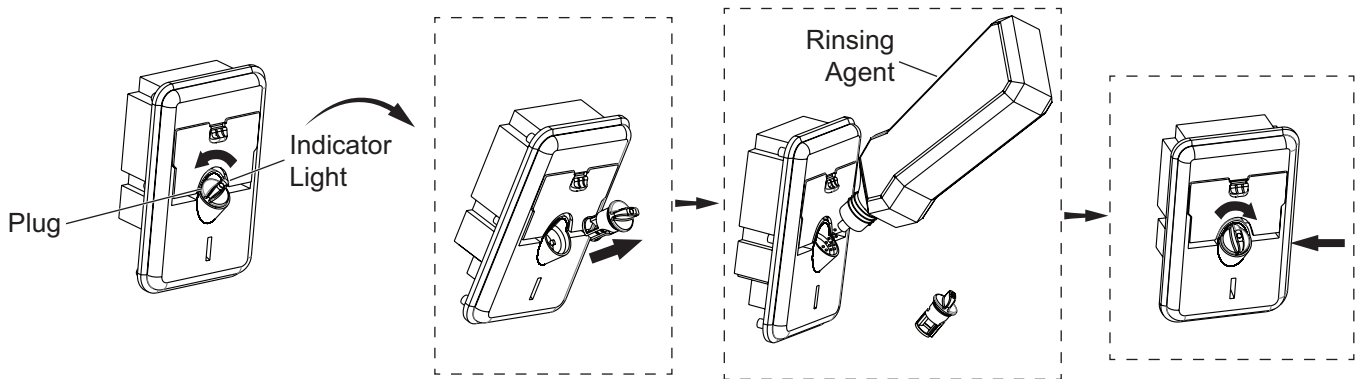


### Specific Cleaners for Dishwasher

1. Open the detergent box, check whether the detergent box is empty and dry, and then add the dishwashing powder.
2. If block detergent washing block is used, put it directly into the dishwasher, open the small object grid cell cover, and place the dishwashing block at the bottom of the basket .

### NOTE:

- Read the precautions carefully for purchasing special cleansers for dishwasher and follow their instructions.
- When using the special dishwashing powder, first place a small amount of dishwashing powder (about 4 ~ 5 g, 1 small bowl for prewashing) into the dishwasher and then place 20g of dishwashing powder into the detergent box (refer to the scale mark for placement).
- Do not add washing block to the detergent box, which affects the washing effect.



### Add the Rinsing Agent

**⚠ WARNING: Risk of product damage.** Do not spill when adding the rinsing agent, wipe the rinsing agent with dry cloth and select the "Strong" program to wash. Failure to wipe may result in excessive foam may be generated which can damage the dishwasher and void the warranty.

**NOTE:** Read the precautions carefully for purchasing rinsing agents for dishwasher and follow their instructions.

- Special rinsing agent for dishwasher (also known as special "brightener" for dishwasher) can remove water marks on glass cups, bowls and dishes, etc., so that the tableware is bright as new.
- The rinsing agent box is inside the drawer and below the detergent box.
- The amount of the rinsing agent used may also be adjusted for actual washing effects (Page 50).

Follow the below steps to add the rinsing agent.

1. Turn the plug counterclockwise and remove the plug
2. Add the rinsing agent to the round hole, and be careful not to splash out the rinsing agent.
3. Reinsert the plug and rotate clockwise to lock the plug. To ensure that the plug is tightened, the handle of the plug is to be in a vertical orientation.

When the rinsing agent is added. If the indicator becomes red, it indicates the need to add the rinsing agent. If the indicator is not on or turns dark, it indicates that no addition is required, and the current rinsing agent is sufficient for the washing program.

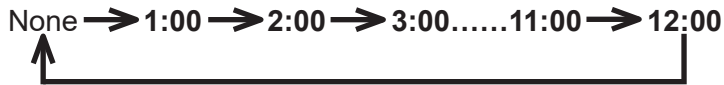

## Operation

**NOTE:** Before operation, put in tableware (Page 40) and put in special cleansers (Page 46) .

### Settings

1. Press the Power button to turn on the power.
2. Press the Program button and select the washing program. Press the Program button each time, to switch between different programs to obtain the desired washing program.  
Standard → Strong → Eco → Small → Ultrafast → Smart → Standard
3. Press the Dry button and select the drying mode. Press the Dry button each time to switch between different modes to obtain the desired drying mode, except when "Smart" program selected.  
30-Minute Drying → 60-Minute Drying → Enhanced Drying
4. Press the Start/Pause button to start running.

### Cancel/Change Settings

To cancel/change settings once settings are complete and started.

- Press and hold the Power button for more than 2 seconds to turn off the power and cancel the settings.
- To change your settings, first unset them in the above way, and then reset them in the same way.

### About "Keep Dry"

Keep the dishwasher dry, prevent condensation in the tableware and dishwasher, reduce water droplet residue and disperse odor.

- Intermittent air supply lasts about 24 hours (48 hours for some models), so intermittent sounds are generated.
- This function will be disabled 24 hours later(48 hours for some models).

### After "Program" and "Dry" program is set

- Press the Reserve button, set the time to start dishwashing, and then press the Start/Pause button to complete the reserve.
- If the reserve function is selected first and then the washing program is selected, pressing the Start/Pause button will not make the reserve valid (Reserve is not displayed in the screen).

## Change Settings



Various settings can be changed depending on your preferences or actual usage.

### Set Drying Duration/Mode

For a better drying effect, change the settings below when extending the drying duration/mode.

1. Once the washing mode is selected, press the Drying button to evoke the current drying duration/mode. Press the Dry button to switch between them in sequence:  
30-Minute Drying → 60-Minute Drying → Enhanced Drying → 30-Minute Drying
2. Press the Start/Pause button to confirm the selected level.

### Setting of Rinsing Agent Usage

- Confirm that the power is turned off.
- Press and hold the Drying button for 5 seconds to enter the rinsing agent usage setting mode.
- The display screen displays the current level. The factory setting is "L3". Once in the setting mode, press the Drying button to adjust the added quantity.
- The codes of totally 7 levels at "L4 → L5 → L6 → L0 → L1 → L2 → L3" will be displayed in sequence.
- After selection, stay for 5 seconds to confirm the selected level automatically.
- The larger the code number, the greater the amount of rinsing agent used. The L6 usage is about 5.4 g, decreasing by 0.9 g per level. L0 indicates that no rinsing agent is used.

# Maintenance

## NOTES:

- Do not remove the tableware for maintenance until 30 minutes after running, which may cause burns.
- Be sure to turn off power before performing maintenance.
- Do not fill water manually during maintenance, to avoid water leakage, damage or agenda alarm.
- If repair or other after-sales service is required due to manual water injection, even during the warranty period, a free warranty is not applicable.
- Do not use bleach, cleanser, diluent, volatile oil, detergent, wax, pesticide, etc., which may cause damage or discoloration.
- Follow the instructions when using chemical rags.

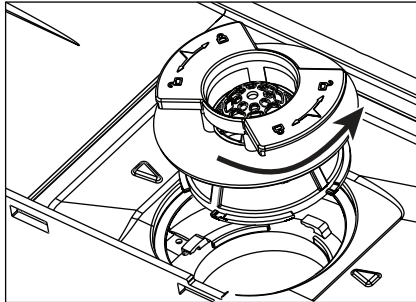

## Clean Filter

**NOTE:** Turn the upper shelf up before cleaning, do not take out the lower bowl basket.

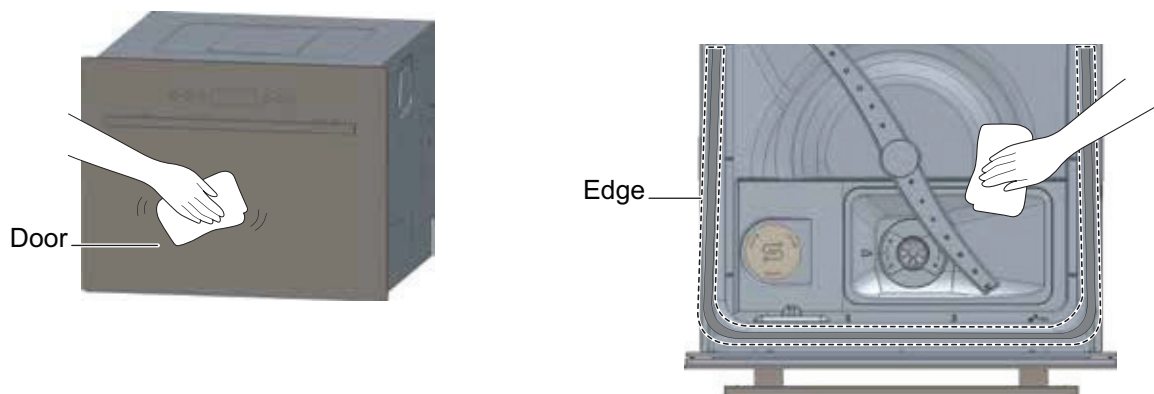
Perform the following operations and remove the filter for cleaning for each cleaning.

1. Hold the handle of the circular filter by hand, and loosen it counterclockwise as shown by the arrow(See Fig. A).
2. Pull the circular filter up again.
3. Rinse the removed circular filter with water. If there is any stain difficult to remove, brush it off with a brush.
4. Put the filter back and tighten the filter. As shown in the dotted line in Fig. B, the circular filter is deemed installed in place when the filter arrow and the metal filter arrow are in a straight line .



- Metal filter can be cleaned once a month, or be removed to clean if too concerned about stains. Remove the circular filter before, then remove the metal filter according to the above steps.
- It is normal that water accumulates at the bottom when the filter is removed.

**NOTE:** If the filter is clogged, may cause poor dishwashing effect or cause mold, odor, water leakage, etc.

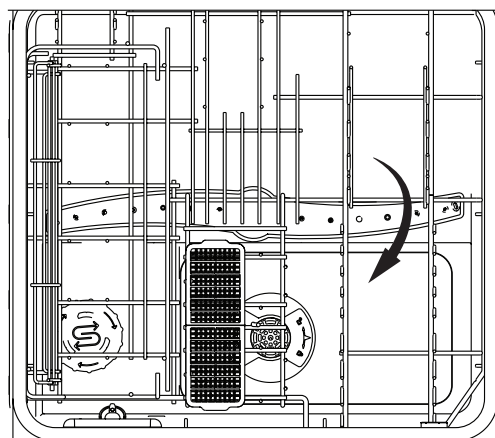


## Main Unit Cleaning

Perform the cleaning operation once a month. Wipe dishwasher parts with a tightened soft cloth.

### Door, Interior, and Edge

- Stains are likely to be accumulated on dishwasher edges and vents . Clean and maintain them carefully.
- If you are too concerned about stains and odors, do not place any tableware, add washing blocks, select "Standard" program for washing, or add a commercially available cleaning agent specific for dishwasher. To maintain the inside of the machine clean, clean the machine in accordance with the cleaning agent's instructions.



### Nozzle Cleaning

- Remove the nozzle (jet arm) and filter for cleaning as shown by the arrow in the figure, turn the small object grid cell shelf up, hold the middle of the nozzle upward and detach from the bottom, and then remove the nozzle along the opening.
- After the jet arm is removed, rinse the food residue attached to the jet arm with clean water. After cleaning, reinstall the nozzle.
- Installation method
  - A. Insert nozzle pipe into body pipe until a "click" sound is heard.
  - B. After installation, make sure the nozzle rotates freely.

**NOTE:** If the nozzle incorrectly installed, the tableware will not be cleaned.

**⚠ WARNING: Risk of product damage.** Do not ignore after freezing, which may damage water inlet valves and pipes. Contact Kohler Co. Customer Care Center for drainage and antifreeze operations.

### Customer Handling

**NOTE:** Do not use when freezing.

1. When frozen, select "Small" program to run for 1 to 2 times to unfreeze.
2. Confirm if the "Ultrafast" program can be performed.
  - If machine is not used for a long time and frozen, then that cannot be unfreeze even after running for 1 to 2 times. Contact Kohler Co. Customer Care Center for the drainage treatment.
  - After thawing (please ignore if not frozen) according to the steps (1 and 2) for customer processing above, proceed to the following steps.
3. Close the inlet valve (See Fig A).
4. Place the water receiving disc under the inlet valve, and then unscrew the inlet pipe with a wrench (see Fig. B).
  - The disc is about 100 mL and 25 mm deep.
  - Keep the filter inside during unscrewing.
5. Press the Start/pause button once the power switch is turned on (see Fig. C).
6. Gently shake or tap into the water pipe to allow all water to flow out (see Fig. D).
7. Press the Power button to turn off the power and pour out the water in the water receiving disc (see Fig. E).
8. Be sure to reinstall the inlet pipe and filter onto the inlet valve. Wait until to check that no longer possibility to freeze, before opening the inlet valve and using the dishwasher.

## FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

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### Poor Cleaning Effect

- Whether the detergent was not placed, or a nonspecific cleanser for dishwasher was placed?  
Put an appropriate amount of specific cleansers in the dishwasher(Page 46~47).
- Whether the tableware touches the nozzle, making the nozzle unable to rotate, thereby affecting the washing effect?
- Whether the tablewares are properly placed (whether they are overlapped or faced wrongly, etc.)(Page 40~42)
- Whether scorched and over-burnt tableware, tableware with oil stains and other difficult-to-clean tableware have been cleaned up first?(Page 34)
- Whether the water used is mineral-rich, etc.?  
Increase the amount of specific cleansers for dishwasher appropriately.
- Whether filter meshes in the machine are blocked?  
Clean the filter meshes(Page 51).
- Whether local water quality hardness has not been consulted and the area code has not been reset?  
If the area code is set, reset the amount of rinsing agent used (Page 50).

### There will be residues when powdered specific cleansers are used.

- Whether the dishwashing powder is damp or agglomerated?  
If agglomerated, please rub and put in the powder.

### Fresh water drip prints on the glass tableware.

- Is the water quality in the area hard?  
If water quality is hard, reset the area code (Page 45) or rinsing agent usage (Page 50).

### Yellowing or slightly darkening of tableware.

- This may be caused by tea scaling or chemical reactions of iron ingredients in water.  
Wipe the tableware by hand frequently.

### Glass tableware becomes white and opaque.

- Occasionally white and opaque glass tableware with small faults on the surface is washed at high temperature.
- Whether there are heavy oil stains on the glass?  
More special cleansers may be added or the "Strong" program may be selected.

### Residual water droplets at the bottom of tableware and poor drying of tableware.

- Whether no specific cleanser or rinsing agent for the dishwasher was placed?(Page 46~47)
- When the bottom of the tableware is concave, moisture may remain.  
Position the tableware slightly inclined(Page 41) or set up to enhance drying, prolong drying time, and reduce moisture residues(Page 50).

## Troubleshooting
