
3. 安装柜子




Mounting-Hole Locations

1. Prepare the Site



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

- □ When determining the height of the product, verify that the door will clear all obstacles (such as a faucet or light fixture). Provide a minimum distance of 3" (76 mm).
- ☐ The distance from the floor to the bottom of the cabinet is about 45-1/4" (1149 mm).
- □ Measure and mark the mounting-hole locations for the bottom hanger(s) and top retaining clips according to the "Roughing-In" section.

2. Install the Bottom Hanger




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CAUTION: Risk of personal injury. This product is heavy. Get assistance lifting and moving the product.

- □ With help, lift and hold the cabinet in position on the wall.
- □ Position the bottom hanger in place under the cabinet on the wall, centered with the centerline of the cabinet.
- □ Verify that the cabinet and hanger are level.
- ☐ With help, set the cabinet down onto a padded surface.
- ☐ If the mounting-holes have not been marked, measure and mark the mounting-hole locations for the bottom hanger(s).
- □ Drill 6 mm pilot holes at the marked mounting-hole locations.
- ☐ Install the provided wall anchors.
- ☐ Secure the hanger with the provided ST3.5X35 screws.

3. Install the Cabinet




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CAUTION: Risk of personal injury. This product is heavy. Get assistance lifting and moving the product.

- □ With help, lift the cabinet and set the bottom of the cabinet onto the hanger. Verify that the bottom of the cabinet hooks and engages the hanger.
- ☐ From the center of the cabinet, insert the top retaining clips into the channel and position a retaining clip to each side of the cabinet.
- ☐ Tilt the top of the cabinet and hold against the wall to mark the mounting-holes for the retaining clips.
- □ Drill 6 mm pilot holes at the marked mounting-hole locations.
- ☐ Install the provided wall anchors.
- ☐ Tilt the top of the cabinet back against the wall and align the holes in the retaining clips with the mounting-holes.
- ☐ Secure the retaining clips with the provided ST3.5X35 screws.

4. Connect the Electrical Supply Wires

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



6. Adjust the Door

Removing the Hinge Cover

☐ Remove the hinge cover to access the adjustment screws.

Left/Right Adjustment

☐ Tighten or loosen the front screw to adjust the door horizontally.


Forward/Backward Adjustment

☐ Tighten or loosen the rear screw to adjust the door depth.

Up/Down Adjustment

□ Loosen the two screws holding the hinge to the cabinet. Adjust the height of the door and tighten the screws to secure the door in the desired position.

7. Install the Shelves





- □ Position one end of the shelf onto one shelf bracket and then press the other end of the shelf down onto the opposite shelf bracket.

8. Install the Accessories

Manual Mode:

- When the light is OFF, press the KOHLER icon to turn ON the light and anti-fog film. The color of all three icons will change to white. When the brightness and color temperature icons are pressed, the color of the icon being pressed will change to blue, and when released, the color of the icon will change back to white.
- When the light is ON, press the KOHLER icon to turn OFF the light. The anti-fog film will automatically turn OFF 30 minutes later. The brightness and color temperature icons will turn OFF and the KOHLER icon will turn white at 50% brightness.
- Press and hold the KOHLER icon for 2 seconds to enter automatic mode.


Automatic Mode:

- When the light is OFF, approaching the mirror cabinet will turn ON the light and anti-fog film. The brightness and
 color temperature icons will change to blue, and the KOHLER icon will change to white. When the brightness and color
 temperature icons are pressed, the color of the icon being pressed will change to white, and when released, the icon
 color will change back to blue.
- When leaving, after approximately 3 minutes, the light slowly turns off and the icons will turn OFF. The anti-fog film will automatically turn OFF 30 minutes later.
- When the light is ON, press the KOHLER icon to turn OFF the light and enter manual mode.
- When the light is OFF, press the KOHLER icon to turn ON the light and enter manual mode.
- Press and hold the KOHLER icon for 2 seconds to enter manual mode.

Backlight

- Open the mirror door and the light turns ON.

9. Adjust the Refrigerator Temperature
